"Lots on here. Quite a bit of flinty, smoky funk of minerality and oak over the more pure fruit characters of green apple, nashi pear and cucumber in tonic water. The palate, despite the excitement of the bouquet, is quite watery and diffuse, delivering less info of fruit, spice and savoury character than the sniffs. Easy drinking anyway; oak elements play an active part despite it being 'neutral'. Medium weight to fuller experience goes OK.."
