VINIFICATION

Hand harvested at a yield of 3.3 tonnes per acre from our Hahndorf vineyard. After crushing and destemming, the juice was split into two parcels - one for cold maceration prior to fermentation, and the other for wild fermentation in a large wooden foudre. The wine was aged for 11 months in a mix 15% new ultra-tight grain French oak barriques, and the rest in more neutral, aged French barriques.
